Removal Procedures:

Note: Below you will find an example of how to use the Ignition Switch Alignment Tool. Refer to service manual to remove switch knob and spring to gain access to the switch. See Fig 1. By installing this tool, it will allow you to still move the switch location needed for removal of the switch housing.

1. Gently place the small diameter end of tool into the top (threaded post) bore of switch housing where you just removed the knob assembly. See Fig 2.

Note: Do not force the tool's tip into the switch. Gently insert. It is designed to move just the internal of the switch housing from one position to the other.

2. After you have installed the tool and turned it back and forth to feel how it moves the switch housing parts, then turn the tools handle gently all the way to the rig ht. Turn the forks gently to rig ht stop, remove top nut with a 7/8" wrench by turning nut counter-clock wise. See Fig 2.

3. Remove a ll other components, collar, spacer, and switch cover plate per the service manual to gain access to switch housing.
