SPROCKET SHAFT BEARING NUT WRENCH

Use to instal I and remove bearing nut on Big Twin 1955-68



WARNING: Be sure to disconnect the battery ground cable.

- 1. Refer to H.D.® Service Manual for specifications.
- 2. Make sure the two holes in the sprocket shaft bearing nut are free from dirt and burrs.
- 3. Slip tool over sprocket shaft and into the two holes, you can tap on end of tool with soft hammer to seat it. CAUTION: This nut has a left hand thread.
- 4. See H.D.® Service Manual for specifications.
- 5. If you are installing an aftermarket bearing nut seal, use JIMS® part #24029-KIT for a no leak seal.
