


INSTRUCTION SHEET FOR TOOL #995



ENGINE CASE SPLITTER
USE ON 2007-PRESENT FL'S & FXST'S.
USE ON 2006-PRESENT DYNA.
USE ON JIMS 120" ENGINE ON
2006 TO PRESENT DYNA & 2007 FL'S.

USE TO PRESS SEALED ENGINE CASE HALFS APART.

NOTE: READ COMPLETE INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING THIS TOOL.

No longer is it necessary to pry or beat the cases apart. This tool will eliminate the need to take the whole assembly to a press to press cases apart.

- See H.D. Service Manual to disassemble engine to the point of splitting the engine case halves.
 Note: Use JIMS No.1022 Engine Stand or JIMS No.1140 Modular Engine Stand for 2006 to present Dyna models while performing this service.
- 2. Locate #7 sprocket shaft plug on end of sprocket shaft.
- 3. Mount the tool to the case with the three lubed 1/4" screws #2 & washers #3 and one lubed 5/16" screw #4 & washer #5 supplied. Tighten so tool is setting flat on case and torque to about 20 ft lbs.
- 4. Lube the threads and the tip of the #1 screw. Tighten center screw #1 a 1/2 turn at a time. Using a brass hammer tap the end of the screw with a firm blow or just enough pressure to relieve stress on the center screw and tool (DO NOT USE AIR OR ELECTRIC IMPACT, THIS MAY BREAK THE CASES OR THE TOOL AND CAUSE BODILY INJURY), turn center screw in a 1/2 turn and hit with brass hammer until screw turns freely.
