

INSTRUCTION SHEET FOR JIMS No.1134, 1135, and 1136 Rolling Buddy

JIMS ROLLING BUDDY IS DESIGNED TO TAKE THE PLACE OF THE ENGINE WHILE IT IS OUT OF THE FRAME, ALLOWING YOU TO ROLL THE BIKE AROUND THE SHOP.

No. 1134- Use on Evo Touring, Dyna, and FXR Models

No. **1135**- Use on 1999-2006 Touring and 1999-2005 Dyna Models

No. 1136- Use on 2007 to present Touring and 2006 to present Dyna Models

RECOMMENDED TOOLS AND SUPPLIES:

- Service Manual for the year and model of bike you are working on
- IIMS No. **904** Center lack
- 9/16 Socket, Ratchet, and open end wrench
- Torque wrench reading Ft/Lbs.
- 1. Follow your service manual to strip motorcycle for engine repair and removal.
- 2. Once the engine is removed from the chassis, install JIMS Rolling Buddy in place of the engine. Use the stock fasteners to install JIMS Rolling Buddy.
- **3.** Torque OEM fasteners to the same torque specifications as the engine mounting bolts. Follow the torque specifications in the service manual.
- **4.** When the engine is ready to install, remove the JIMS Rolling Buddy and install engine per H-D service manual.
