Installation

- 1. Disconnect battery or remove Maxi-fuse.
- 2. Drain primary lubricant and remove primary cover following Service Manual.
- 3. Lock primary with locking bar or use a **VT No. 16-2753** . Remove compensator bolt using 13/16 socket and breaker bar. Remove stock thrust washer and stock sprocket retainer.
- 4. Install new thrust washer and VT No. 19-0475 or 19-0487 with new compensator bolt. Be cautious when tightening that you don't catch the thrust washer on the shoulder of the new sprocket retainer.
- Torque to specification following service manual guidelines.
- 5. Line up the lock ring with the holes in the retainer.
- 6. Install the locktab with two 10-32 hex screws using blue threadlocker and tighten to 22 In/lbs. Bend the locktabs up against the flats of the hex screws.
- 7. Re-install new primary gasket, cover and add lubricant following H-D service manual. If you used a **VT No. 16-2753**, remove it and install the crank position sensor.
- 8. Re-install Maxi-fuse or re-connect battery cables.
