- a. See the service manual to remove the fairing.
- b. Remove and retain the two cap screws beneath the upper fork bracket that hold the existing lower handlebar risers in place.
- c. Move the handlebar assembly from the installed position. Carefully allow gauges and handlebar to rest on vehicle.
- d. Remove and discard cup washers, rubber bushings and spacers.
- a. See the service manual to remove the fairing.
- b. Remove and discard the two cap screws beneath the upper fork bracket that hold the existing lower handlebar risers in place.
- c. Move the handlebar assembly from the installed position. Carefully allow gauges and handlebar to rest on vehicle.
- d. Remove and discard cup washers, rubber bushings and spacers.
- a. Remove and retain the two cap screws beneath the upper fork bracket that hold the existing lower handlebar risers in place.
- b. Move the handlebar assembly (from the installed position. Carefully allow gauges and handlebar to rest on vehicle.
- c. Remove and discard cup washers, rubber bushings and spacers.

NOTE

The new upper and lower bushings must be oriented with the larger diameter ends opposite each other as shown.

- 2. Install the new polyurethane riser bushings in place of the removed cup washers, bushings and spacers.
- 3. Align components.
- 4. 2014 and Later Touring Models: Secure components with two new hex head cap screws. Insert the cap screws, from the bottom, through the upper fork bracket, through the bushings and into the handlebar risers. See the service manual for torque specification. ALL Other Models: Secure components with two hex head cap screws removed in Step 1. Insert the cap screws, from the bottom, through the upper fork bracket, through the bushings and into the handlebar risers.

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
